### **Blue Career Fairs**

Career Days 2018 at the University of Cyprus, Nicosia, Cyprus, 24th – 26th April 2018

MENTOR participated in the Career Fair event on April 26 with its own dedicated kiosk. The Career Fair was organized by the Career Office of the University of Cyprus. Representatives of Cypriot MENTOR Team discussed with interested students, provided guidance and answered questions regarding the aims of the project and the blue career prospects in Cyprus. The MENTOR leaflet was distributed to the students, while the new videos of MENTOR were shown.

The MarInEM team participated in the career fair of the Cyprus University of Technology. The project had a

stand during the entire event and the MarInEM team members provided guidance to the participants, while they delivered a presentation on the aims of the project, the blue professions and the outcomes of the first deliverables of the project focusing on the blue career prospects in Cyprus.

## Cyprus International "Education and Career" Fair 2018, 23th - 25th February 2018, Nicosia, Cyprus

Representatives of UCY and CCCI represented MENTOR at the Cyprus International "Education and Career" 2018 Fair, discussed with interested students about the blue careers, and answered to their questions. The exhibition was organized by the Ministry of Education and Culture of Cyprus, the Cyprus Chamber of Commerce and Industry (CCCI) – a MENTOR partner, the Cyprus Employers and Industrialists Federation (OEB) and the European Office of Cyprus (EOC), in cooperation with the British Council of Cyprus.

## **MENTORing of Youngsters -**




MENTOR project partners arranged about 50 visits at high schools across Romania, Greece, Cyprus and Bulgaria during the first half of 2018. The main objective of the events was to offer guidance to high school pupils regarding the Blue sectors. The invited speakers tried mentoring the high school students on becoming part of an international network of professionals, working in the Blue sectors. Another objective was to increase their awareness and properly inform them on job opportunities and relevant prospects. Presentations were held and leaflets were distributed among the attending students, as the provided career guidance was informatively relayed through a discussion with the

pupils. After the events, the interested students were prompted to provide their contact details so that they could be invited for future happenings and to be further advised on the forthcoming MENTOR e-learning courses to be developed within the project.
