Implementation Guideline of 2019 DUO - Thailand Fellowship Programme

General Information

DUO -Thailand Fellowship Programme aims to enhance a balanced mobility of students between Thailand and 30 ASEM member states in Europe ¹ by supporting paired-based and two-way exchanges. In this respect, the programme requires that a PAIR (two persons) of students be exchanged in the framework of cooperative project/ cooperation between higher education institutions in Thailand and in 30 ASEM member states in Europe.

Eligibility	Eligible universities for the DUO - Thailand Fellowship Programme should abide by the following obligations:				
	 A Thai university and a European university should have an agreemen at the institutional level whereby credits for study undertaken while or exchange are to be accepted by its partner institution. 				
	 The Thai and European universities already having an agreement with its partner institution will be given first priority. The institutions utilizing student exchange to pave the way for developing an agreement with its partner institution will be given second priority. 				
	 The Thai and European universities must permit their students to participate in an exchange all through the duration of the programme: 1 semester.
